1. Add new Question C12: *“Colon cancer.”*
2. Delete old Question C20e: *“sinusitis, a sinus infection that required antibiotics.”*
3. Delete old Question C20f: *“UTI, a urinary tract infection or an infection in your bladder or kidneys that required antibiotics.”*
4. Add new Question C20e: *“kidney problem or kidney disease.”*
5. Question C24: Delete the following hepatitis medications:
 - a. 090 – *Interferon alfa-2b (Intron A)*
 - b. 708 – *Infergen (Interferon alfacon-1)*
 - c. 213 – *Famvir (famciclovir)*
 - d. 711 – *Alinia (nitazoxanide)*
6. Add Questions C36h and C36hi: *“Have you received any of the following vaccinations: herpes zoster (shingles)?”* and *“When was the last time?”*
7. Add Questions C36i and C36ii: *“Have you ever received any of the following vaccinations: HPV (human papillomavirus)?”* and *“When was the last time?”*
8. Question E10a-e: Delete subquestion i *“Have you been in [PROGRAM] in the past six months?”* as this question is now asked on the F24BEH form at the baseline visit.
9. Revise Question E11: *“Have you ever used either medical or recreational marijuana, cocaine, crack, heroin, methamphetamine, hallucinogens, club drugs, or any other illicit or recreational drugs?”* Use of amphetamines and prescription drugs will now be asked in Question E27.
10. Replace old marijuana/hash use questions with the following:
 - a. E12: *“Have you ever used marijuana or hash to get high, for medical reasons, or both?”*
 - b. E12a: *“Did you have a prescription from a medical provider for medical marijuana?”*
 - c. E12b: *“On average, how often have you used medical marijuana or hash?”*
 - d. E12c: *“On average, how often have you used marijuana or hash recreationally?”*
11. Add new Question E27: *“Have you ever used any prescription drugs in ways that were not prescribed? Not prescribed means that you didn’t have a doctor’s prescription for the drug, you used more than was prescribed, or you used it to get high.”*
12. Revise Question E23 and renumber to E28a: *“Have you ever used methadone in a way that was not prescribed? Not prescribed means that you didn’t have a doctor’s prescription for the drug, you used more than was prescribed, or you used it to get high.”*
13. Revise Question E23a and renumber to E28b: *“On average, how often have you used methadone in a way that was not prescribed?”*

14. Revise Question E27 and renumber to E28c: *“Have you ever used any other prescription narcotic drugs, such as morphine, codeine, oxycodone, or Demerol, in a way that was not prescribed? Not prescribed means that you didn’t have a doctor’s prescription for the narcotic, you used more than was prescribed, or you used it to get high.”*
15. Revise Question E27a and renumber to E28d: *“On average how often have you used any other prescription narcotic drugs in a way that was not prescribed?”*
16. Revise Question E24 and renumber to E28f: *“Have you ever used amphetamines (speed, uppers) in a way that was not prescribed?” Not prescribed means you didn’t have a doctor’s prescription for the amphetamine, you used more than was prescribed, or you used it to get high.”*
17. Revise Question E24a and renumber to E28g: *“On average how often have you used amphetamines in a way that was not prescribed?”*
18. Revise Question E30 and renumber to E28h: *“Have you ever used any tranquilizers, such as sleeping pills, barbiturates or valium, in a way that was not prescribed? Not prescribed means you didn’t have a doctor’s prescription for the drug, you used more than was prescribed, or you used it to get high.”*
19. Revise Question E30a and renumber to E28i: *“On average, how often have you used tranquilizers in a way that was not prescribed?”*
20. Add new Questions E40d, E40di, E40dii: *“suboxone program.”*
21. Add new Questions E40e, E40ei, E40eii: *“other medication-assisted drug treatment.”*
22. Add new Question E40eiii: *“What drugs have you used in this treatment?”*
