

**Medication History (F22MED)**

1. Add new prompt after Question B2a: *“If participant brought medication bottles or list to report ARV use, please ask the following question (B2b) and make sure all medications are checked in Question B2a. If participant is HIV-negative, or interviewer has already reviewed Photo Med Cards with participant, circle “3” for N/A and proceed to Question B2c.”*
2. Question B2b: Revise text to read (changes underlined): *“Besides the [bottles/list] that you brought in today, have you tried any other antiretroviral medications even for a short period of time, since your (MONTH) study visit?”*
3. Question B2b: Add new response category, *“not applicable.”*
4. Question B6: Revise text to read (changes underlined): *“Since your (MONTH) study visit, has there been a period of time of one week or more when you were off treatment (PROBE: not taking any of your antiretroviral medications)?”*
5. Add new Question B11: *“Since your (MONTH) study visit, have you taken medications to prevent getting HIV infection – this is sometimes called pre- or post-exposure prophylaxis, PEP or PrEP?”*
6. Add new Question B11a: *“Have you ever taken medications to prevent getting HIV infection?”* This question will be deleted for visit 35.
7. Add new Question B12: *“From where did you get the medication?”*
  - a. Your primary care provider or clinic
  - b. A clinic such as an STD or public health clinic
  - c. A non-clinical person, such as a friend or person on the street
  - d. As part of a study
  - e. Other (SPECIFY)
8. Add new Question B13: *“Are you still taking it?”*
9. Add new Question B13a: *“In what year did you first take this medication?”*
10. Add new Question B14: *“Are you taking or did you begin to take this medicine **after** having a possible unprotected sexual or drug injection exposure?”*
11. Add new Question B15: *“Are you taking or did you begin to take this medicine for your general protection (and not prompted by a risky exposure)?”*
12. Add new Question B16: *“For how long did you or will you take this medication?”*
13. Question E12a: Add new medication, *“hydrochlorothiazide.”*
14. Question E12h: Add new medication, *“albuterol.”*
