

Medication History (F22MED)

1. Add newly FDA-approved ART Complera, a combination of emtricitabine, rilpivirine, and tenofovir.
2. Questions B2c, C1i and D1b: Bold and underline **NOT** in question to clarify which response is to be circled if participant has not taken any of the listed medications.
3. Question B4: Revise question to ask about whether participant has “*changed, restarted or stopped*” any of her ARV medications since her last visit. Question did not previously ask about restarting medications.
4. Delete Question B11a: “*Have you ever taken medication after sex to protect against getting HIV?*” “*Since last visit*” version of question will remain on form.
5. Question D1a: Add field in which to record “*other*” hepatitis medications that may not be specifically listed on the form.
6. Question E2: Delete “*Some people who were sick with the H1N1 flu have also reported vomiting and diarrhea*” from introduction to flu questions as we no longer ask about H1N1 flu vaccine or illness.
7. Question E13: Reword prompt to interviewer to read “*Enter the total number of other prescription medications recorded in the F22MEDs6 section.*”
8. Question E13: Add prompt “***ALL COMPLEMENTARY/ALTERNATIVE THERAPIES SHOULD BE REPORTED IN SECTION F, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THEY ARE PRESCRIBED.***”
