1. Delete old question B1: “Since your (MONTH) study visit, were you treated for any cervical or other abnormality?”
2. **For 10/01/05a version**, correct wording in B1a: “Since your (MONTH) study visit, were you treated for an abnormal Pap smear or **an abnormal** biopsy of the cervix?”
3. Add B1b: If B1a is “yes,” ask: “Was that treatment: 1) cryosurgery (freezing of the cervix); 2) loop, LEEP or LETZ (electrical cutting of the cervix); 3) laser conization or ablation (a laser was used); or 4) hysterectomy (major surgery under anesthesia; the uterus was removed).”
4. Add B1c: “Since your (MONTH) study visit, were you treated for any other gynecological conditions?”
5. Add B1d: If B1c is “yes,” ask: “What were you treated for?”
6. Delete questions B9d – B11d: “Approximately how many weeks were you pregnant?” This question was asked as part of the Pregnancy Protocol, which has been discontinued.
7. On page 4, delete prompt requesting that women who deliver a live or stillbirth be enrolled into the Pregnancy Protocol, which has been discontinued.
8. Delete question E22: “Have you experienced pain in the lower part of your belly (pelvis)?”
