

Obstetric, Gynecological and Contraceptive History (F23)

1. Add new question B1a: “*Since your (MONTH) study visit, have you had a Pap test? (PROBE: Pap smear, Papanicolaou test, a test for early detection of cancer of the cervix.) (PROMPT: Do not include Pap tests that were performed by WIHS.)*”
2. Add new question B1b: “*Were you told the Pap test was abnormal?*”
3. Add new question B1c: “*Since your (MONTH) study visit, did you have colposcopy? (PROBE: Colposcopy uses an instrument like binoculars to examine the cervix.) (PROMPT: Do not include colposcopic exams that were performed by WIHS.)*”
4. Add new question B1d: “*Since your (MONTH) study visit, were you treated for any cervical abnormality?*”
5. Renumber old question B1b to B1e: “*Was that treatment: Cryosurgery (freezing of the cervix); Loop, LEEP or LETZ (electrical cutting of the cervix); Laser conization or ablation (a lawverer was used); Hysterectomy (major surgery under anesthesia; the uterus was removed); None of the above.*”
6. Renumber old question B1c to B1f: “*Since your (MONTH) study visit, were you treated for any other gynecological conditions?*”
7. Renumber old question B1d to B1g and reword: “*For what were you treated?*”
8. Question F7: Clarify on form and in QxQs that response option “*pending*” means results have not yet been provided to participant. If the results have been received, but were not clearly abnormal/normal and participant was simply instructed to return for additional testing, this is not considered “*pending*.” In this case, interviewers should circle response option “*Other*.”
