

Combination Drug Treatments for HIV

In addition, these drugs may also be used by an HIV negative person following a possible exposure to HIV (e.g., through unsafe sex or needle sharing) to try and prevent infection with HIV. This is called "post-exposure prevention," or PEP for short.
