

Medication History (F22MED)

1. Add Question B2a: “Since your (MONTH) study visit, have you taken any antiretroviral medications?” A “no” response will allow participant to skip over all questions related to ARV medication use and adherence.
2. Revise old Question B2a and renumber to B2b: “What antiretroviral medications have you taken?”
3. Question B2a: Add 2 new ARV medications.
 - a. Drug code 295 – Prezcoibix (DRV + cobicistat)
 - b. Drug code 296 – Evotaz (ATZ + cobicistat)
4. Renumber old Question B2b to B2c.
5. Delete old Question B2c: “Participant has/has not taken any ART SLV.” This information will now be recorded in Question B2a.
6. Question B7: Revise order of subquestions a through d and renumber so 30-day adherence questions precede since last visit adherence question.
7. Move old Question B10 to B17.
8. Add Question B8: “Is participant HIV-positive or HIV-negative?” If participant is HIV-positive, questions regarding PEP/PrEP will not be asked.
9. Question D1a: Add 3 new HCV medications.
 - a. Drug code 717 – Harvoni (ledipasvir + sofosbuvir)
 - b. Drug code 718 – Viekira Pak (ombitasvir/paritaprevir/ritonavir tablets + dasabuvir tablets)
 - c. Drug code 719 – Daclatasvir
10. Delete question E1 and E1a-g: “Since your (MONTH) study visit, have you received any of the following vaccinations?”
11. Delete Question E2: “During the last flu season, did you get the regular flu vaccine?”
12. Delete Question E11b and E11b i-vii: “What are the main reasons you are taking hormone replacement therapy?”
13. Question F1b: Add “St. John’s Wort” to form.
14. Delete Question F1b iii: “Main reason for taking” alternative/complementary medications.
